Timbermax TG uses 13 layers of European-engineered coating to ensure a tough and durable surface that is able to stand up to daily wear and tear when maintained correctly. Timbermax TG is also stain resistant and has an added protective layer to ensure your floors are well protected.

Timbermax TG uses the original Tongue and Groove (T&G) installation profile, which makes it an easy DIY option, and gives the timber extra spill protection in the joints by using a water resistant glue. This significantly reduces water damage as well as any squeaking issues that can occur in other types of timber floors.

You can have peace of mind with a Timbermax TG engineered floating floor knowing it is warranted against warping and cupping - a common occurrence in other timber floors.


